

Duncan's crayons draw all sorts of objects, from red fire engines and gray elephants to green dinosaurs, blue oceans, and pink princesses.




DRAGONS LOVE TACOS 1, Adam Rekin Buttald by Daniel Salmieri


Dragons Love Tacos Adam Rubin

Harold wants to take a walk in the moonlight, so he draws the moon with his purple crayon.







How Do Dinosaurs Say Good Night? Jane Yolen

Relating the cycle of requests a mouse is likely to make after you give him a cookie taking the reader through a young boy's day.






BB Llama Llama Nighty Night Anna Dewdney

Simple text and illustrations portray a day in baby's life.






The Monster at the End of this Book: Starring Lovable, Furry Old Grover Jon Stone

When Chester the raccoon is reluctant to got to kindergarten for the first time, his mother teaches him a secret way to carry her love with him.






The Mitten Jan Brett


A retelling of the traditional tale of how a boy's lost mitten becomes a refuge from the cold for an increasing number of animals...until bear sneezes.
