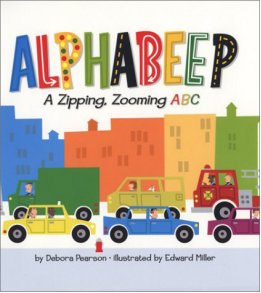

BB = Board Book

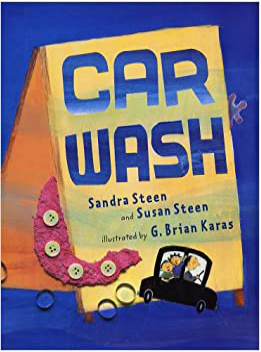


**Alphabeep: A Zippering, Zooming ABC** Debora Pearson

Mighty dump trucks, tough tow trucks, giant cement mixers, and other powerful vehicles tackle the jobs ordinary trucks can't handle.

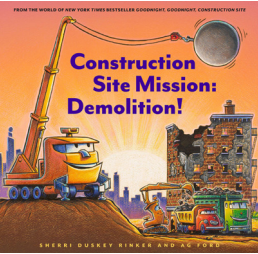


**Car Wash** Sandra Steen

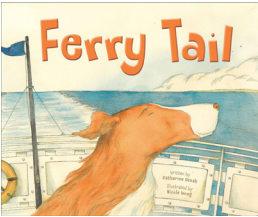
A simple trip to the car wash turns into a deep adventure.

In rhyming text, the vehicles of the construction crew set to work demolishing an old rickety building--the necessary first step to building something new.



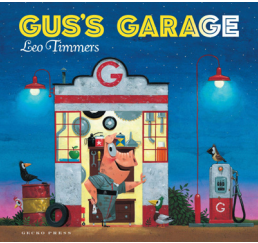
**Ferry Tail** Katharine Kenah



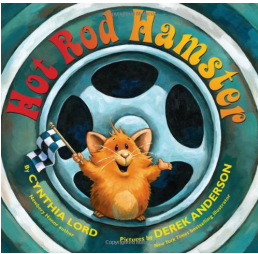

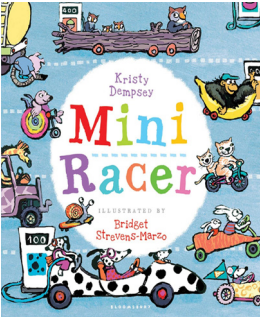
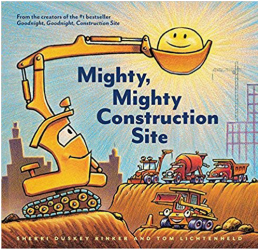
**Hot Rod Hamster!** Cynthia Lord

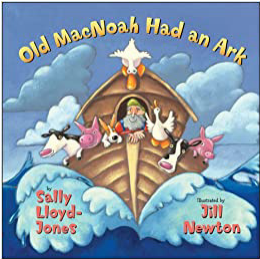
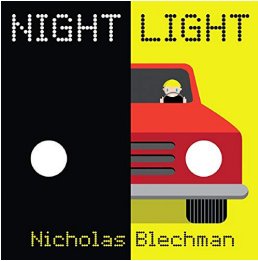


**Mini Racer** Kristy Dempsey

Count the lights, and through die-cut pages, find out which vehicle they belong to.



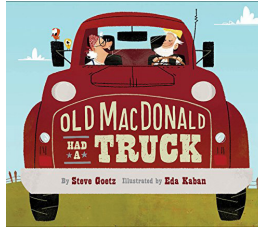
**Old MacNoah Had an Ark** Sally Lloyd-Jones

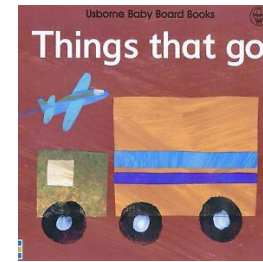
An update of the classic folk song, Old MacDonald, featuring farm vehicles like excavator, dump truck, and bulldozer.

## BB Peek-a Choo-Choo

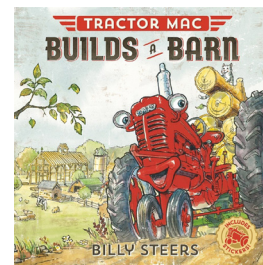
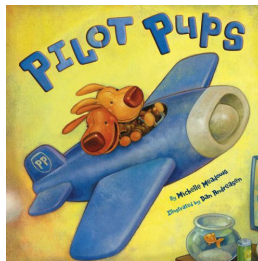

## Tractor Mac Builds a Barn

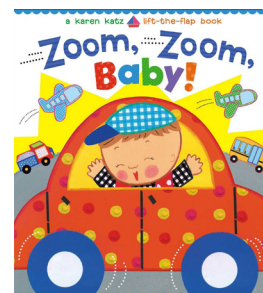
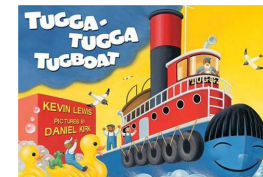

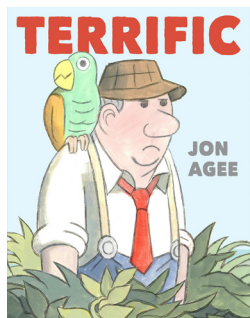
A rhyming story about a toy tugboat's day, from pulling tankers and barges to putting out fires.

Young readers are invited to lift flaps to reveal animals riding in such vehicles as trains, planes, and trucks.



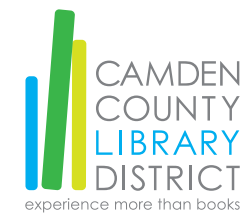
## Terrific
