





Narrative Summary for 2022

Director: Michael Davis

Personnel:

The Camden County Library District employed 32 employees as of 2022, with 18 being full-time, 14 being part-time, and 24.3 full-time equivalent (FTE). This is a slight increase from the 29 employees in 2021. The district added three part-time employees, two in circulation and one in maintenance. Carolee Apperson, a long-time branch manager, retired and was replaced inhouse by Amy Danalds, who was promoted to Branch Manager at the Climax Springs Branch.

Facilities:

The Camden County Library District operates six branches, including the headquarters in Camdenton and branches in Climax Springs, Macks Creek, Osage Beach, Stoutland, and Sunrise Beach. All facilities are in good condition. The Stoutland branch received a new roof in October 2022. General maintenance was performed at all branches to keep them in good condition. The district is also exploring the possibility of renting out the old radio station facility next to the Osage Beach Library that the district purchased in 2018.

The Community Garden behind the Camdenton Library saw significant upgrades in 2022. New outdoor signage was installed along Rodeo Road to promote the garden, and new beds were added. Dirt, mulch, plants, and tools were donated by local businesses, who were recognized with signage on the garden fence. Due to the upgrades, all 16 garden beds were used during the growing season, and plans are in place to add more donated garden beds in the future.

Programs & Services:

In 2022, the libraries returned to normal services and programs after the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. Program attendance returned to pre-pandemic levels, with 11,669 people attending the 1238 programs presented. The libraries answered 139,403 reference questions and 361 people applied for passports at the Osage Beach branch. The Summer Reading Program had 954 enrollments and a 50% completion rate, with 3956 attendees at the 54 SRP programs and an average attendance of 73 per program. Free walk-in public notary services were added at all branches in 2022, and documents were notarized for 320 people.

Technology:

The district undertook several technology projects in 2022. Library staff switched from Google Suite to Microsoft Office 365 for email, online data sharing, and office suite, saving the district over \$6000 per year. An IMLS grant was obtained through the State Library to upgrade the Makerspace with three 3D printers, a 3D scanner, and larger monitors for staff and public. The Camdenton Board Room was also upgraded with a large-screen TV and videoconferencing hardware for teleconferencing.

Policies and Planning:

The Library Board of Trustees adopted or revised several policies in 2022, including the By-laws of the Camden County Library District, Education Reimbursement Policy, At-Will Employment Policy, Personnel Records Policy, Software Copying Policy, Computer Communications Policy, Disclosure of Library Records Policy, Expense Reimbursement Policy, Safety Policy, 3D Printing Policy, Severe Weather Policy, Service Animal Policy, Marketing/Public Relations Policy, Social Media Policy, Probationary Pay Scale Policy, Sick Leave Policy, Vacation Policy, and Leave of Absence Policy. The library also completed a Disaster Plan and distributed disaster flip charts to all branches.

Circulation:

The Camden County Library District holds 104,524 physical items, including books, audiobooks, DVDs, and more, and 57,482 digital items, including eBooks, audiobooks, magazines, and videos. In 2022, physical and digital items were circulated 190,941 times,
