Section 2. Operating Policies Subsection 23. 3D Printing Policy

The Library's 3D printers are available for patron and staff use to make three-dimensional objects using a design that is uploaded from a digital computer file.

The Library's 3D printers may be used only for lawful purposes and shall **not** be used to create objects that are:

- 1. Prohibited by federal, state, or local law.
- 2. Unsafe, harmful, dangerous, or pose an immediate threat to the well-being of others.
- 3. Inappropriate for the Library environment.
- 4. A violation of copyright, patent, or trademark laws,

The fee for using the 3D printer is 15 cents per linear meter of filament. Printed 3D items not picked up within seven business days become Library property. Printed 3D items must be picked up by the individual who printed them. Only designated Library staff will have hands-on access to the 3D printer. The Library reserves the right to refuse any 3D print request.

Any individual using the Library's 3D printer under the supervision of Library staff agrees to assume responsibility for and shall hold the Library harmless in, all matters related to the individual's use of the 3D printer and the printed objects(s).
